

Arica port has become established during the last years as a dospot of cruise ships, offering an excellent service for tourists arriving to know about the history, culture and natural beauties of the Region Arica y Parinacota.



The operations at this port are carried out by the licensee Terminal Puerto Arica (TPA).





## INFRASTRUCTURE FOR TOURISTS

Arica's port has the Integral Tourist Centre (CTI), a venue of 1200 square meters specially enabled to provide first-class facilities to a thousand of tourists that annually arrive to the region.

The venue is specially prepared for cruise ship tourists. It includes:

- Resting areas.
- Restrooms.
- Free Wifi.
- Customs area.

Passengers are moved from and to the ships through a shuttle bus service that delivers them at the CTI so they can walk around the historic center of the city found across the port venue.

Arica is qualified as a secure port worldwide thanks to the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code (ISPS), so it has a strict security and control mechanism in every visit.

Once at the venue, an Entrepreneurs' Fair is set up at each cruise dock, offering visitors different products with regional identity, highlighting the use of noble and traditional materials from the region that have become unique elements.





The Arica and Parinacota region is located in the north other end of Chile. The main characteristic of the city is that it offers sun to visitors during the whole year, and a wide range of tourist attractions both in the city and in the highland area.

One of the main attractions of the region are the Chinchorro Mummies, ancient inhabitants of the area. These mummies are more than 8,000 years old and their mummification technique was developed a long before the Egyptian one. In 2021, the Chinchorro Culture was recognized as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

Natural attractions are also important such as the Lauca Biosphere Reserve, which is composed of the Lauca National Park, Las Vicuñas National Reserve and Salar de Surire Natural Monument; the only one of its kind in the north of the country, which is located more than 4 thousand meters above the sea level.

Its powerful history is strongly connected to the original ethnic groups of the Andean peoples. This is reflected every year in the Andean Carnival Con La Fuerza Del Sol, which gives life and color to the city and it's due in the middle of the Cruise Season. The entire region prepares to welcome visitors and get them steeped in the best of its traditions and culture.









The Port of Iquique is located in the Tarapacá region, on the northern coast of Chile.

## INFRASTRUCTURE FOR TOURISTS

• Public-private partnership:

Within the framework of the Collaborative Logistics Plan, a partnership is already underway with the Undersecretariat of Crime Prevention of the Tarapacá region for the use of drones for remote surveillance. This way, upon arrival of cruise ships, preventive action is available, including monitoring tourist groups heading toward urban areas, maintaining control and coordination with the entities responsible for maintaining order, both in the port and in public spaces (Navy, Carabineros, and the municipality).







The contrast of landscapes and attractions that the Tarapacá Region has make it the ideal destination for those willing to enjoy extreme sports or the simple rest on a sunny day. Enjoy the sea on one of the most beautiful coasts and beaches of Chile, the desert with the history of the nitrate era and the unmistakable flora and fauna of the pristine highland landscape, full of native culture.









With over 100 years of history, Puerto Antofagasta is a key institution in the logistics and commercial development of northern Chile. Its infrastructure includes two berths and seven berthing positions, with a total length of 600 meters and a draft ranging from 9 to 14 meters.

Specializing in services for metallic and non-metallic mining, the port offers ship reception and cargo storage operations. Its capacity allows it to handle vessels of up to 9,600 TEUs and 347 meters in length.



Port of Antofagasta is currently promoting key projects to modernize and expand its operational capacity. These include:

- Expansion of the Shelter Molo
- La Negra Logistics Development Zone
- Modernization and expansion of the Portezuelo Outport

These initiatives will double port capacity and efficiently respond to growing demand, driven by new industries such as green hydrogen and lithium, regional mining expansion, and the consolidation of the Bioceanic Corridor.





Located in the historic center, in the heart of the city, Port Antofagasta is close to various tourist attractions, such as the Historic District, Plaza Colón, Casa Gibbs, Mall Plaza Antofagasta, Melbourne & Clark Dock, the Regional Library, and the Antofagasta Museum, among others.

It's also just a few hours from must-see destinations such as San Pedro de Atacama, Mejillones, the Mining Route, and the Astronomical Route, making it a strategic point for those wishing to explore the region's natural and cultural riches.









#### **INFRASTRUCTURE**

The Port of Coquimbo has three berths, one of them recently inaugurated, 300 meters long and 14 meters deep, and two others that together total 378 meters long and 9 meters deep.

In addition to a passenger terminal that has equipment for baggage check, restrooms and Wi-Fi connection.



Arriving in The Port of Coquimbo offers the possibility of sightseeing the most touristic sectors at a short distance from the port. It is in the heart of the city; passengers of cruises can walk through the city and visit the safe areas without taking any additional transportation.

To facilitate the transfer of passengers inside the port area, there is the possibility of taking the shuttles or approach buses service, which allow a quick and safe transfer to the passenger terminal for immigration and luggage checking, with vehicles suitable for passengers with reduced mobility.



Valparaíso, known as the "Jewel of the Pacific", is distinguished by its unique architecture and its colorful hills that offer panoramic views of the entire bay. Declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, this city is home to a rich history, culture and traditions, offering a wide range of attractions that invite you to walk its streets, ascend endless stairs or enjoy its traditional elevators.



**Gastronomy:** Gastronomy in Valparaíso stands out for its diversity and for taking advantage of the freshness and quality of fish and seafood, but it also has traditional and own preparations such as "chorillana". To combine landscape and gastronomy, the offer of cafes, restaurants and bars on the Alegre, Florida and Concepción hills is ideal.

San Antonio is Chile's main port, located 120 km from Santiago and 106 km away from to Airport. One of his port operators, DP World San Antonio, has an exclusive terminal to receive passengers and crew of the cruise ships.

Located just 250 meters from the berthing dock and with more than 3,600 square meters of space for its use, the San Antonio Passenger Terminal has all the necessary infrastructure for the National Customs Service's activities, the Agriculture and Livestock Service, the Maritime Authority and Investigative Police, providing the best attention, security and agility for passengers who are embarking, disembarking or in transit arriving at San Antonio.

This is the terminal's main berth of local port (EMPORMONTT) with 21 acres as yard where cargo and cruise ships are transferred. It has a 386-meter-long dock with two floating docks and a passenger terminal for cruise ships.

#### **Puerto de Castro:**

A 1-hectare terminal in Chiloé for cargo from the aquaculture industry, cruise ships, and connectivity. It has a 187 m2 Terminal for serving cruise passengers, equipped with sanitary services.

This new facility of USD \$3,000,000 of investment will provide a better guest and crew experience thanks to its 1,300 m2. This counts with a 150 meters covered platform that connects the floating pontoons with the new passenger terminal, including amazing viewing points where both passengers & crew members will be able enjoy the local landscape and Puerto Montt' Bay and Isla Tenglo and its surroundings.

We enable a Coffee Shop on the second floor which will be offering a great view of the bay.

The New Passenger terminal is integrated and connected with the new coastal avenue and park. Also, include a parking lot for 150 buses and minor vehicles.

Since 2017, EMPORCHA offers especially designed facilities for the reception of cruise ship passengers and crew members.

The terminal was thought to allow conditions to provide a pleasant stay at the port facilities.

It was built right next to the bascule bridge that connects the floating deck with the coast line, so that passengers and crew have to walk only a few meters to access the terminal.



This deck offers 3 different docking fronts, allowing service for three ships simultaneously, or else the transferring to other ships if necessary.

It is connected to the coast line by a bascule bridge, with capacity for small vehicles.

For all and every cruise ship visit, EMPORCHA offers professional English speaking staff to be available during the entire stay, placing them in strategic places, as the floating deck, in order to facilitate communication with both visitors and crew members.





In order to accomplish this goal, we place our facilities at their service, pre arrange and coordinate actions necessary with local authorities and other services that must be implemented exclusively for the reception of each and every cruise ship, such as:





Although the summit will be held in the Magallanes and Chilean Antarctic Regions, the Pre-Summit Adventures will showcase the adventure attractions of Chile's various macroregions, so companies with operations throughout the country are eligible to participate.

The corporation is available to work with CLIA to host a FAMTOUR for cruise line destination development executives. On that date or another to be agreed.

## Undersecretary of Tourism and National Public Police to develop the Cruise Industry in Chile

We live in a privileged land, of exceptional geographical and cultural beauty and diversity. In each corner of Chile resonates the richness of its nature and of our traditions, which makes us an unrivaled tourist destination in the world: from the colorful celebrations of the highlands or the imposing Rapa Nui moais, to the amazing biodiversity from Patagonia.

Aware of this reality and the importance of promoting more equitable development of the regions of the country, the Government took on the challenge of drawing the first National Sustainable Tourism Strategy for Chile.

The Undersecretary of Tourism will announce, towards the end of July, a public policy associated with a cruise tourism strategy. This, as a result of our request made in January 2024, when we proposed an ad hoc text.





# Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications and National Port Logistic Police which includes a special Chapter related to the development of the Cruise Industry in Chile

The transformations in the maritime industry have important effects on the port activity. The shipping market has experienced a very relevant process of change in recent decades, characterized by the appearance of larger ships dimensions and capacity. The real operation of the system requires coordination and additional responsibilities to those provided for in the legal framework.

The Ministry of Transport and Telecommunications will announce its National Port Logistics Policy in the second half of 2025, which will have a particular chapter associated with cruise ships, from the perspective of the transport authority. Needless to say, the base text was also provided by the Corporation.
